

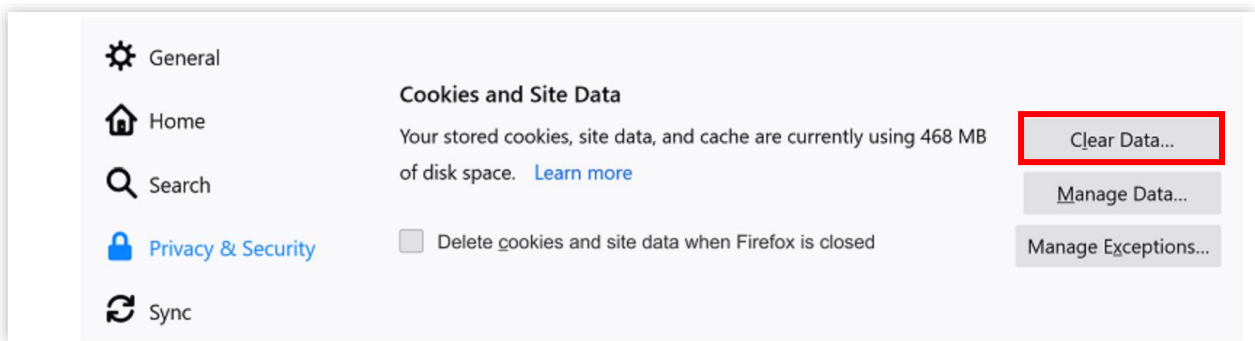

Clear cookies and site data in Firefox

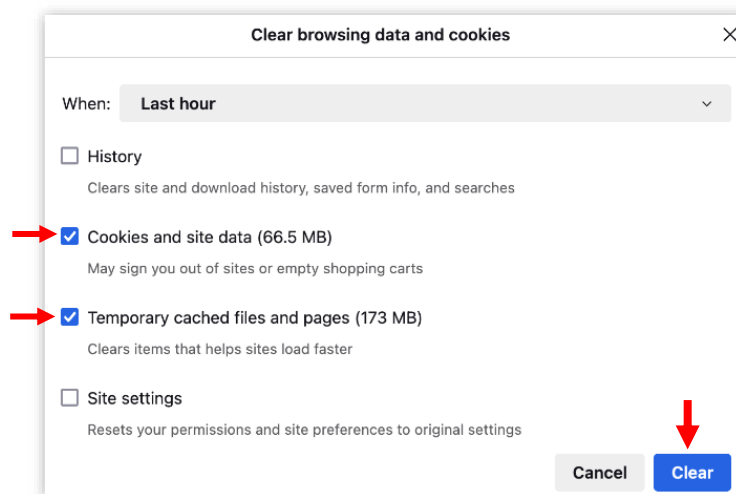
[Cookies](#) are stored on your computer by websites you visit and contain information such as site preferences or login status. This article describes how to delete Firefox cookies, other site data and [cached web content](#).

Clear all cookies, site data and cache

1. Click the menu button ☰ and select **Settings**.
2. Select the **Privacy & Security** panel and go to the **Cookies and Site Data** section.
3. Click the **Clear Data...** button.



4. In the **Clear Browsing Data and Cookies** dialog window, check the boxes for **Cookies and site data** (to remove login status and site preferences) and **Temporary cached files and pages** (to remove stored images, scripts, and other cached content). *Be sure all other boxes are unchecked.*



5. Click **Clear**.
6. It is recommended to close the browser completely for the changes to take effect. Click the X at the top right corner to close the browser. After the browser closes completely, click to open it again and continue working.
